



Parking Information – Fall 2023

Parking enforcement in Student "B" lots begins at 6:00am on Friday, September 8th

Parking is free in B lots after 3:45 p.m. on weekdays and at any time on the weekend

All permits are now virtual – your license plate acts as the permit. There is no more forgetting to hang your permit and no more waiting for your permit in the mail.

Requesting semester-long parking permits:

If you would like a semester-long permit, please fill out the 105-066 Vehicle Registration Form to "register" your car. Since each vehicle's license plate is used as your parking permit, license plates must be registered accurately to avoid being issued a citation. These permits are valid in Staff Parking Lots (A lots). This permit is not valid at parking meters.

- 1) Fill in your name, address and information about your car.
- 2) Leave the EMPLID box empty and leave the check boxes empty.

Requesting short-term parking permits:

If you are subbing for a class and would like a short-term parking permit, please email <u>interpreters@nvcc.edu</u> so we can start the process of issuing a temporary permit. Please know that it will take several days to get a temporary permit.

If you need to park on campus but <u>don't have time to request a temporary permit</u>, you may park in the visitor parking spots. Visitors may park at hourly parking meters or garages for \$2 per hour. Special Campus/Center Instructions:

- 1) Medical Education Campus (Springfield/MEC): Faculty/Staff parking is only available on levels four and five of the parking garage. Parking on other floors may result in a ticket.
- 2) No parking permits are required to park at the Pitney Bowes building, the Reston center or Pender buildings.
- 3) Signal Hill: no parking permit required. However, you may only park in the yellow parking spots.
