In the first 30 credits, students must: a. Complete ENG 111 and ENG 112 with a C or better. b. Complete the first college-level MTH course with a C or better. 5. Students must complete at least six degree-applicable credits with a C or better each fall and spring semester. 6. Students must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA. 7. Students must apply for NOVA graduation and complete their Associate's degree.
