Introduction

Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA) uses a variety of measures to evaluate student achievement and success. NOVA is committed to the values of access, opportunity, student success, and excellence. In particular, the College aims to provide students access to high-quality, postsecondary education in the Northern Virginia region, as well as to promote success by preparing students to graduate, transfer or enter the workforce with the highest level of educational and labor market skills.

NOVA demonstrates its commitment to the values of student access and success through wellestablished processes in place to evaluate and improve student achievement. In particular, NOVA measures eight criteria as reported to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC): 1) College Readiness; 2) Enrollment; 3) Course Success; 4) Retention; 5) Graduation; 6) Transfer; 7) Employment; and 8) Licensing Exams.

This report provides critical updates to an earlier report series examining students transferring out of NOVA. This updated report shows trends in transfer rates over time (Section A) and looks at the most popular transfer institutions for NOVA students (Section B).

Transfer figures are based on data from both the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) and the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC), as provided by Virginia's Community Colleges (VCCS).

This report indicates that the number of NOVA students who transfer has increased in recent years. The proportion of transferring students who identify as ethnic or racial minorities has also increased, and the number of NOVA students who transfer with an award (degree or certificate) has increased. The report is intended to assist NOVA administrators, faculty, staff, and other stakeholders in helping the College to optimize its curricula and programs to benefit students as they navigate from NOVA to their transfer institutions and beyond.

Executive Summary

Section A. Transfer Trends





Figure 1. Transfers to Four-Year Institutions: 2019-20 through 2021-22

- Over 14,000 NOVA students transferred to a four-year institution during the 2021-22 academic year, a 14 percent increase over 2019-20 (**Figure 1**).
- In 2021-22, 80 percent of transfers to four-year institutions (11,206 students) transferred to a public institution rather than a private institution (**Figure 1**).
- From 2019-20 to 2021-22, the number of NOVA students transferring to public institutions increased by 16 percent, and the number of NOVA students transferring to private institutions increased by 5 percent. The number of students transferring to Virginia schools increased by 12 percent from 2019-20 through 2021-22 (**Figures 1 & 2**).




Figure 3. Frequency of Transfers to Four-Year Institutions: 2021-22

- In 2021-22, NOVA students transferred to four-year institutions located throughout 49 states, as well as Washington, D.C., and Puerto Rico (Figure 3).
- Among transfers to four-year institutions in Virginia, the percentage of students who are of a minority race or ethnicity increased from 58 percent to 61 percent from 2019-20 to 2021-22 (Figure 4).
- The number of NOVA students transferring without a NOVA award increased 16 percent from 2019-20 to 2021-22, while the number who transferred with a NOVA award increased by 8 percent (**Figure 5 & Table 2**).
- Among students who transferred with a NOVA award during the 2021-22 academic year, 74
 percent earned an A.S. degree and 19 percent earned an A.S. in General Studies (the most
 common credential awarded) (Figure 6 and Tables 3 & 4).
- Most NOVA students who earned a degree or award prior to transferring to a four-year institution were in the General Studies pathway at NOVA (28 percent in 2021-22) (Table 5).

Section B. Top Transfer Institutions

- Between 2019-20 and 2021-22, most NOVA transfer students enrolled at George Mason University (GMU). In 2021-22, 3,638 NOVA students transferred to GMU. The next highest number of transfers were to Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (Virginia Tech) (1,254 students), James Madison University (JMU) (1,106 students), and Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) (1,055 students) (Figure 7).
- 61 percent of students who transferred with a NOVA award enrolled at GMU in 2021-22 compared to 14 percent of transfers without an award (2,196 compared to 1,442 students, respectively). (**Table 6**).

Section A. Transfer Trends

The number of NOVA students who transfer to a four-year institution has increased over time.

- Over 14,000 NOVA students transferred to a four-year institution during the 2021-22 academic year, a 14 percent increase over 2019-20.
- In 2021-22, 80 percent of transfers to four-year institutions (11,206 students) transferred to a public institution rather than a private institution (Figure 1).
- The number of NOVA students transferring to a public institution increased by 16 percent from 2019-20 to 2021-22. Transfers to private institutions increased by 5 percent during the same period.

Between 2019-20 and 2021-22, 68 percent of NOVA transfer students enrolled at a school located in Virginia. The number of students transferring to Virginia schools increased by 12 percent during this period.



In 2021-22, NOVA students transferred to four-year institutions in 49 states, as well as Washington, D.C., and Puerto Rico (**Figure 3**).

Most NOVA transfer students in 2021-22 enrolled at four-year institutions in Virginia (9,530 transfers), Pennsylvania (412), Washington, D.C. (374), Maryland (367), Florida (278), and New York (249) (**Table 1**).



Of transfers to four-year institutions in Virginia, the percentage who are of a minority race or ethnicity increased from 58 percent to 61 percent from 2019-20 to 2021-22.

The implementation of guided pathways and the creation of the ADVANCE partnership with George Mason University (GMU) are expected to help increase the number of students who earn a NOVA degree or award before transferring to a four-year institution.

- From 2019-20 to 2021-22, the number of NOVA students who transferred without an award increased 16 percent, while the number who transferred with an award increased by 8 percent.
- In 2019-20, 3,324 students completed a NOVA award before transferring. In 2021-22, 3,579 students completed a NOVA award before transferring (Figure 5).

Most NOVA students who earn a degree or award prior to transferring to a four-year institution earn an A.S. degree. Between 2019-20 and 2021-22, 74 percent of students who completed a NOVA degree or award before transferring earned an A.S. degree (Figure 6).

Among students who transferred with a NOVA award during the 2021-22 academic year, the most common credential was the A.S. in General Studies (19 percent) (**Table 4**).

Some students have transferred with multiple awards. To monitor the progression of NOVA students along specific tracks, we identify their initial award as their designated pathway. The majority of NOVA students who secured a degree or award before moving to a four-year institution pursued the General Studies and General Education pathway at NOVA, with 28 percent doing so in 2021-22. In the same year, 18 percent of NOVA graduates who transferred were from the Computer Science and Information Technology pathway, while 22 percent followed the Business and Public Services track.



Section B: Top Transfer Institutions

This section presents data on the most popular transfer institutions for NOVA students. Between 2019-20 and 2021-22, most NOVA transfer students enrolled at George Mason University (GMU).¹

- In 2021-22, over 3,500 NOVA students transferred to GMU.
- The other top transfer institutions in 2021-22 were Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (Virginia Tech), James Madison University (JMU), Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU), the University of Virginia (UVA), and Old Dominion University (ODU).

Among private, nonprofit four-year transfer institutions, most NOVA students transferred to Liberty University, George Washington University (GWU), Marymount University, Western Governors University, Southern New Hampshire University, and Shenandoah University.

Students who transfer after earning a NOVA award are more likely to enroll at certain four-year institutions, compared to those who transfer before earning a degree or certificate at NOVA.

- 61 percent of students who transferred with a NOVA award enrolled at GMU in 2021-22 (2,196 students); in comparison, 14 percent of students who transferred without an award enrolled at GMU (1,442 students).
- A larger number of students without a NOVA award transferred to Virginia Tech, JMU, VCU, UVA and ODU compared to students with a NOVA award.

Conclusion

As NOVA works to better understand student transfer behavior and seeks to facilitate the transfer process, it is imperative that the College strive to prepare students for their education beyond NOVA. The data presented in this report showed the variety of diverse institutions that NOVA students attend upon transfer.

It is essential for NOVA stakeholders to gain further insight into the transfer trends and patterns of the College's students. This report shows that, in recent years, the number of NOVA students who transfer out has increased and the number of transfer-out students who identify as being of minority race or ethnicity has also increased.

The analysis presented in this report provides data regarding the transfer patterns of students who either graduate from NOVA before transferring or who leave NOVA without earning a degree. This information is intended to be helpful in further optimizing programs such as ADVANCE—a collaboration between NOVA and its most popular transfer institution, George Mason University—a program that shows signs of success. Information about students' transfer patterns, including transfer with or without a credential and to which institutions, can aid NOVA's faculty and staff in planning pathway improvements.

All students can benefit from having clear pathways when transferring from community college to four-year institutions. While not all students earn a credential before they transfer, research suggests that community college students who earn associate degrees may be better positioned not only for transfer but also for their career beyond college. This is partly because students who transfer without first earning a degree may be unable to transfer all of the credits that they earned while attending community college.² Furthermore, sub-baccalaureate educational attainment in the form of earning degrees and other credentials is associated with higher lifetime earnings compared to earning a high school diploma only.³ This research report has contributed to the field of analysis through an examination of students' transfer patterns, either with or without a degree or credential, beyond their learning experiences at NOVA.
