Point-in-Time Enrollment Comparison of Area High School Graduates: Fall Registrants in 2016 vs. 2015

This Research Brief compares the rate at which recent high school graduates in NOVA’s service area registered at NOVA for the fall semester, regardless of the term in which they originally applied. The data in this document provide a point-in-time comparison: Monday, August 8, 2016, compared to Monday, August 10, 2015.

A. All Recent High School Graduates by Campus

- Overall, the number of recent high school graduates registered at NOVA was 3 percent lower in Fall 2016 (4,714) than on the comparative date in Fall 2015 (4,849).
- The number of registrants increased slightly at Alexandria Campus (5 percent) and at Woodbridge Campus (4 percent) but decreased at all other campuses.

B. All Recent High School Graduates by Campus and High School

- From Fall 2015 to Fall 2016, the number of registrants **decreased** at:
 - 3 of 10 Alexandria Campus area high schools.
 - 9 of 16 Annandale Campus area high schools.
 - 9 of 15 Loudoun Campus area high schools.
 - 10 of 11 Manassas Campus area high schools.
 - 4 of 8 Woodbridge Campus area high schools.
