**2017-18 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates
Enrolled at NOVA in Fall 2018**

This Research Brief presents data on Northern Virginia public high school graduates who graduated in 2017-18 and enrolled at Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA) in Fall 2018. The Northern Virginia region is of primary interest and encompasses eight public school divisions: Alexandria City, Arlington County, Fairfax County, Falls Church City, Loudoun County, Manassas City, Manassas Park City, and Prince William County.

**Section 1. 2017-18 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates
Enrolled at NOVA by School Division: Fall 2018**

Section 1 presents 2017-18 Northern Virginia public high school graduates enrolled at NOVA in Fall 2018 by school division. Data are organized by school division with affiliated high schools presented alphabetically.

- Overall, 21 percent of 2017-18 Northern Virginia high school graduates enrolled at NOVA in Fall 2018.
- The three high schools with the greatest *percentage* of graduates who enrolled at NOVA were: Robert E. Lee (33%), Falls Church (31%), and Gar-Field (30%).
- The *school division* with the greatest proportion of 2017-18 public high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA during Fall 2018 was the Prince William County school division (25%).

**Section 2. 2017-18 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates
Enrolled at NOVA by Nearest Campus: Fall 2018**

Section 2 displays 2017-18 Northern Virginia public high school graduates enrolled at NOVA in Fall 2018 by nearest campus. Data are organized by NOVA campus with affiliated high schools presented alphabetically.

Although high schools are affiliated with NOVA campuses due to their proximity, students may select any NOVA campus as their “home” campus. The number of graduates enrolled at NOVA are therefore also reported by NOVA “home” campus (AL, AN, LO, MA, ME, WO). The Medical Education Campus is not affiliated with any particular high school due to the specialized nature of its programs.

- The *service area* with the highest percentage of 2017-18 recent high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA in Fall 2018 was the Woodbridge Campus service area (25 percent of the high school graduates in that area).
- The high schools with the largest *numbers* of students enrolled at NOVA in Fall 2018 were Patriot (189 students, 26%), Woodbridge (181 students, 29%), Gar-Field (172 students, 30%).
