










#### **GENDER BY CAMPUS**




#### **RACE/ETHNICITY BY CAMPUS**






### **ENROLLMENT STATUS BY CAMPUS**


#### STUDENT TYPE BY CAMPUS









#### DOMICILE BY CAMPUS






## DAY/NIGHT STATUS BY CAMPUS


#### **CLASS MODE BY CAMPUS**
