HB1547 – Effect July 1, 2020. Students who meet specific criteria shall be eligible for in-state tuition regardless of their citizenship or immigration status (exception: students with currently validF, M, J, or H-3 Visas). Taxes: This law requires the review of 2 years of Virginia Income Taxes of the student (if Independent) or the Parent/Legal Guardian/In loco Parentis (if Dependent) Two years of Federal taxes and other documents are necessary for verification of dependency or Tax Exemption Status.
